In 2006-07, I had the distinct privilege of serving as Scoreboard Coordinator for the Florida Community College Activities Association. From the opening day of men's and women's basketball on November 1 to the final out of the FCCAA Gulf District Baseball Tournament on May 8, coaches from four sports (men's basketball, women's basketball, baseball and softball) reported scores and game highlights via voice mail or email, which were, in turn, posted to each sport's respective scoreboard page.

During basketball season, coaches turned in ballots for 17 Top Ten Coaches Polls, beginning with a preseason poll, released on October 31 and ending with the final regular season Top Ten on March 2. Baseball and Softball coaches submitted a Top Ten ballot 13 times, beginning with a preseason Top Ten, released on January 26 and ending with the final poll on April 26. Additionally, Players of the Week (and Pitchers of the Week for baseball and softball) were selected and announced with the release of each Top Ten poll.

Through on-line software set up by the NJCAA, each school was responsible for maintaining individual and team statistics during the season. Statistics reported by each coach were displayed on the Region VIII Statistics page, also maintained by the NJCAA. Although this was a new concept for a number of coaches across the state one which included somewhat of a learning curve, I feel that everyone should be commended for a job well done.

The hard work and commitment from each school's coaching staffs made my job a breeze! I appreciate your efforts during the 2006-07 season. Thank you for the opportunity to serve the FCCAA!

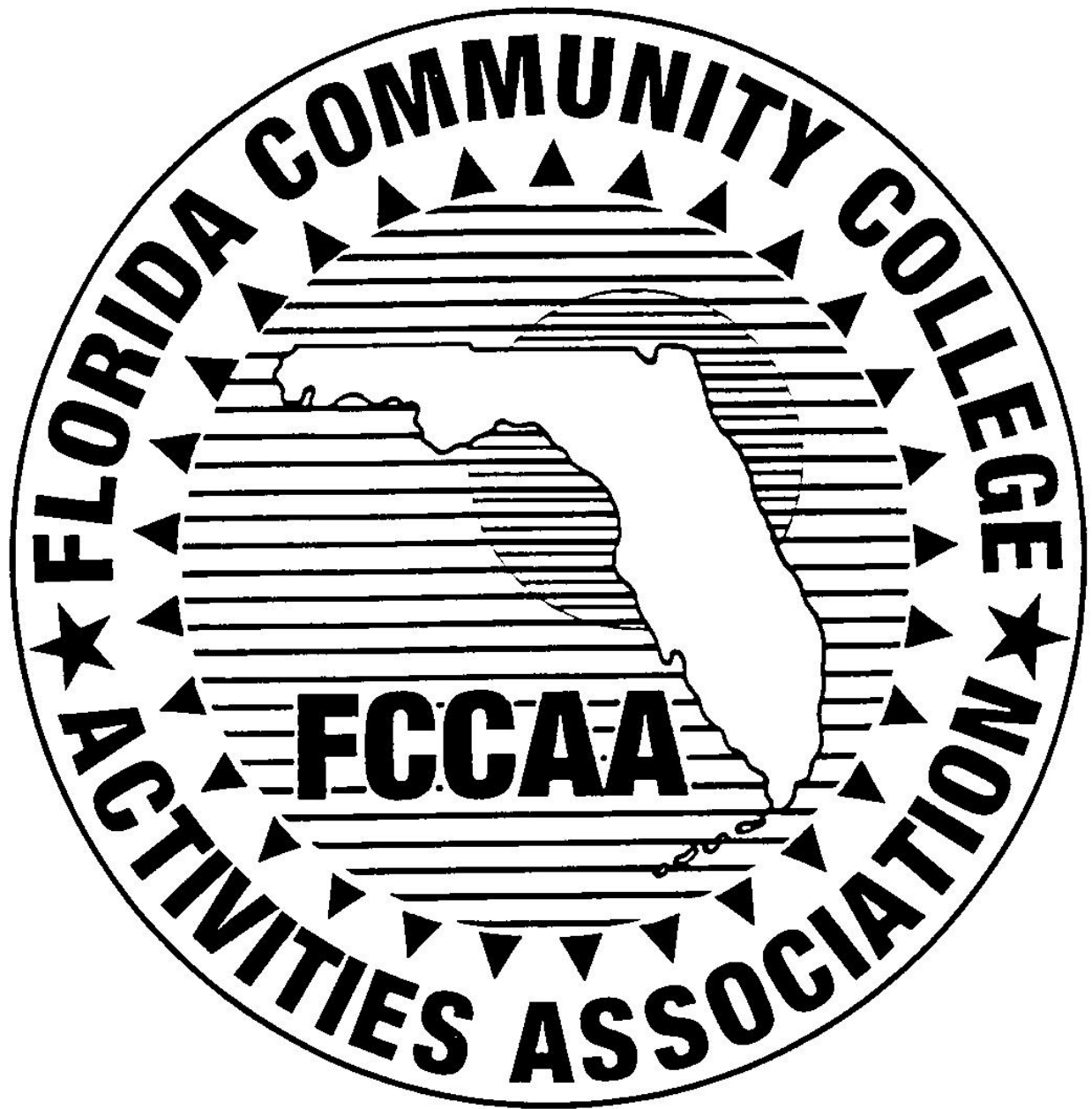
